This is a program of the **Cemetery and Burial Grounds Registry, Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology, Department of Natural Resources** (www.IN.gov/dnr/historic).

Cemetery and Burial Grounds Registry, Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology, Department of Natural Resources

Both historic cemeteries and prehistoric burial areas are located in our state. Cemeteries are part of our cultural landscape in which more and more citizens are becoming interested. Indiana Code 14-21-1-13.5 directs the Indiana Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology (DHPA) to create a registry of all cemeteries and burial grounds in each county in Indiana. Knowing the location of as many cemeteries as possible in the state will help provide better protection of these resources.

Eligibility Requirements to Obtain Cemetery Heritage Signs:

1. A cemetery must be listed in the DHPA Cemetery and Burial Grounds Registry, established by Indiana Code 14-21-1-13.5. Contact DHPA at DHPA@dnr.in.gov to determine if a cemetery is listed.

Guidelines for Obtaining Cemetery Heritage Signs:

- Complete this application (do not send money) and send to: Cemetery Registry Coordinator; Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology, DNR; 402 West Washington Street, Room W274; Indianapolis, IN 46204.
- 2. Applicant may be awarded more than one sign for the same site.
- 3. Applicant will be billed for the full cost of the sign(s), delivery, and tax, as applicable.



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ORDERING INFORMATION

Once the form has been sent to the DNR-Division of Historic Preservations and Archaeology (DNR-DHPA), the Cemetery Registry Coordinator will process the application, assuring that all aspects of the form are complete. Then DNR-DHPA will send the applicant an invoice for the cost of the sign (see the DNR-DHPA website at www.in.gov/dnr/historic for current cost) and applicable sales tax. Payment must be received before sign(s) will be ordered and manufactured. The text for the sign(s) will be submitted for the applicant's approval.
