Special Requirements

- 1. Fluid discharge shall take place only during daylight hours.
- 2. The owner or operator shall maintain a written record of each storm water discharge per 312 IAC 29-24-2(f).
- 3. The drain line shall have a valve installed that shall remain closed when not in use and must be capped or otherwise secured to protect against vandalism or unauthorized discharges.
- 4. A permanent sign shall be placed within five (5) feet of the drain pipe discharge that identifies the owner or operator and the storm water discharge authorization number assigned by the division.
- 5. Leaking tanks or vessels shall be promptly taken out of service and repaired.
- 6. Failure to comply with the provisions of 312 IAC 29-24-2 may result in the withdrawal of the authorization to discharge uncontaminated storm water.
