Instructions for Completing Form FT-1

Purpose of this Form

Form FT-1, Fuel Tax License / Registration Application, is used to register your business with the Indiana Department of Revenue (DOR) for fuel-related activities. It should be submitted prior to fuel related activity occurring.

You can complete the Fuel Tax License / Registration Application electronically via INTIME, DOR's e-services portal, at intime.dor.int.gov. You can also mail the completed application, required documentation, and license payment fee(s) to the address listed on the front of the form.

Section A: Applicant Information

Complete all fields. If you do not yet have a 10-digit Indiana Taxpayer Identification Number, leave this blank.

Section B: License / Registration Information

 Check the box for each one that applies. If a bond or financial statement is required, be sure to include it with your application.

Special Fuel Supplier - A person who imports or acquires immediately upon import into Indiana special fuel by pipeline or marine vessel from within a state, territory, or possession of the US into a terminal or that imports special fuel into Indiana from a foreign country, or that produces, manufactures, or refines special fuel within Indiana, or that owns special fuel in the pipeline and terminal distribution system in Indiana.

Special Fuel Permissive Supplier - Any person who does not meet the geographic jurisdictional connections to Indiana required of a supplier, but who holds an inventory position in a federally qualified terminal located outside of Indiana and who is registered under Section 4101 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Special Fuel Terminal Operator - The person who by ownership or contractual agreement is charged with the responsibility and physical control over the operation of the terminal. A terminal means a fuel storage and distribution facility that is supplied by pipeline or marine vessel, and from which special fuel may be removed at a rack and that has been registered as a qualified terminal by the Internal Revenue Service.

Special Fuel Exporter - Any person, other than a supplier, who purchases special fuel in Indiana for the purpose of transporting or delivering the fuel to another state or country.

Special Fuel Importer - A person who causes undyed special fuel to be delivered into Indiana on the person's own behalf, for the person's own account, or for resale to an Indiana purchaser, from another state in a fuel transport vehicle having a capacity of more than 5,400 gallons, or in a pipeline or barge shipment into storage facilities other than a qualified terminal.

Special Fuel Transporter - A person who is not licensed as a supplier who transports special fuel by truck, barge, rail or pipeline from a point outside of Indiana to a point inside Indiana, or from a point inside Indiana to a point outside Indiana, regardless of whether the person is engaged for hire in interstate or intrastate commerce.

Special Fuel Blender - A person who is engaged in the mixing of one or more petroleum products, with or without another product, excluding biodiesel or blended biodiesel, if the product obtained by the blending is capable of use in the generation of power for the propulsion of a motor vehicle, an airplane, or a motorboat.

Dyed Fuel User - A person who is purchasing red dyed low sulfur diesel and who qualifies for the federal diesel fuel tax exemption under Section 4082 of the Internal Revenue Code to operate motor vehicles on the highways with dyed fuel in the supply tank.

Gasoline Distributor - A person who first receives gasoline in Indiana or who desires to receive gasoline within Indiana without paying the gasoline tax to the supplier.

Gasoline Use Tax Permit Holder - A distributor, refiner, or terminal operator looking to receive gasoline within Indiana without paying the gasoline use tax must hold a permit in order to collect payments of the gasoline use tax from purchasers and recipients.

Gasoline Transporter - A person who is not licensed as a distributor who transports gasoline by truck, barge, rail or pipeline from a point outside Indiana to a point inside Indiana, or from a point inside Indiana to a point outside Indiana, regardless of whether the person is engaged for hire in interstate or intrastate commerce.

Marina Fuel Exemption Permit Holder - A person who operates a marina or boat livery on Lake Michigan or the Ohio River that sells tax free gasoline at that facility for the exclusive purpose of propelling motorboat engines.

Aviation Fuel Exemption Permit Holder - A person who operates an airport or a person engaged in business at an airport, who sells tax free gasoline at that facility for the exclusive purpose of propelling aircraft engines or motors.

Oil Inspection Fee Reporter - A person who distributes jet fuel, kerosene, naptha, distillates, or fuel oil and who does not have a gasoline distributor license or any special fuel license(s).

Petroleum Severance Reporter - A person who purchases or receives petroleum (hydrocarbons produced at a well in a liquid or gaseous state) at the time of severance from the land.

Section C: Special Fuel Supplier Details

- Enter the estimated number of annual gallons to be imported in each field.
- You must submit a surety bond (Form SF-2) or cash deposit (Form MF-134) in an amount that covers two months of your estimated tax liability or \$2000, whichever is greater.

Section H: Special Fuel Transporter Details

- Indicate if you will transport special fuel within, into or out of Indiana.
- Attach a list of all vehicles that will be used on the highways of Indiana. Changes to the list of vehicles in use must be submitted to the department on an annual basis.

Section M: Gasoline Transporter Details

Section N: Marina Fuel Exemption Details

- Indicate if you operate a marine facility located on Lake Michigan or the Ohio river and sell gasoline at that facility for the exclusive purpose of propelling motorboat engines.
- 2. Provide the address of the location, name of gasoline supplier and the storage capacity.

Section O: Aviation Fuel Exemption Details

- Indicate if you operate an airport and sell gasoline there for the exclusive purpose of propelling aircraft engines/motors.
- Indicate if you sell gasoline at an airport where the gasoline is sold for the exclusive purpose of propelling aircraft engines/ motors.
- Provide the address of the location, name of gasoline supplier and the storage capacity.

Section P: Oil Inspection Details

- 2. You must submit a surety bond (Form MF-202) of \$2000.

This section does not need to be completed if you hold or are applying for a Gasoline Distributor License or any Special Fuel License.

Section Q: Petroleum Severance Details

Indicate if you will purchase or take possession of petroleum at the time of severance from the land. Petroleum means all hydrocarbons produced at a well in a liquid or gaseous state.

Section R: Tax Pre-Collection Agreement

Special Fuel Suppliers and Permissive Suppliers must select one option from the choices.

Section S: Waiver

This section should be completed if you wish to give the department permission to share tax return information with your fuel provider/customer to resolve reporting discrepancies. This waiver may apply to all license types held by the taxpayer. This waiver is an optional form, and you are not required to complete this section. If you do not sign the waiver, you may be contacted and requested to send additional information concerning your return in the event of reporting discrepancies.

Section T: Signature

The application must be signed and dated by the owner, general partner, or a corporate officer listed in Section A of this application. You must also include the person's title and a phone number at which this person may be reached. This paper application will not be processed without a signature.

Additional Information

Some of the license types for which this application is being filed require a surety bond, cash bond, or letter of credit. To determine the required bond amount, check the license type(s) for which you are applying. This figure must be rounded up to the nearest thousand-dollar amount. All special fuel types may be included on one bond form. The bond should indicate each license type and the amounts being covered. A separate bond is required for the gasoline license types. Bond forms are available at www.in.gov/dor/tax-forms/fuel-tax-forms.

All bonds must be completed, signed, and notarized with a Power of Attorney attached before any license(s) can be issued.

Before submitting your license and bond information, be sure to:

- Complete all required sections of the license application.
- If applying for a Special Fuel Exporter license, include a copy of your fuel license/permit for each destination state.
- Include an executed surety bond, letter of credit, or cash bond equal to the amount required for each license type, if applicable.
- Include a current financial statement, beginning balance sheet, or year-end report.
- This application, required documentation, and the payment of any applicable license fee(s) may be either:
 - Completed online via INTIME, DOR's e-services portal at intime.dor.in.gov. OR
 - By mailing this completed application, required documentation, and license payment fee(s) to the address listed on the front of the form.
