DESIGN PROFESSIONAL MUST INITIAL EACH ITEM.				
	Separate cooking facilities (kitchen) in each home (stove or microwave, refrigerator and sink). Bathroom sink cannot be used as kitchen sink.			
	Separate bathroom facilities in each home. Bathrooms must of	contain bathing facilities, either a tub or shower in each unit.		
	Separate outdoor fenced in play areas.			
	Two (2) separate exits per home (one must go directly outside and the second can go through a non-child care area such as a hallway, vestibule, porch, etc.; however, that area must be separated by two (2) hour fire walls).			
Must have a two (2) hour fire wall between the homes. Fire wall is required to go from the dirt to the shingles, with fire dampers wherever there is duct work. The two (2) hour fire wall must go from the ground through the roof for a distance of thirty feet (30") OR to the roof with four (4) feet of fire resistant material on each side of where the wall terminates at the roof. Any openings or anything that penetrates through the wall has to be sealed or dampered.				
If there is a door between the two (2) homes, the door frame and door must be fire rated for one and a half (1½) hours. Door must be closed at all times. A self closing device is required on fire doors. This door cannot be used as a throughway.				
Licensed home that is on top of another licensed home (second story or basement) must have a two (2) hour fire resistive ceiling / floor assembly. This would include the floor of the upper level and the ceiling to the floor directly below.				
Separate electrical panels for each home. Separate thermostat for heat in each home. Separate main gas and water shut-offs.				
Smoke alarms are interconnected within each unit.

Indiana Code 22-12 FIRE SAFETY, BUILDING, AND EQUIPMENT LAWS: GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

IC 22-12-1-5

"Class 2 structure"

Sec. 5. (a) "Class 2 structure" means any part of the following:

- (1) A building or structure that is intended to contain or contains only one (1) dwelling unit or two (2) dwelling units unless any part of the building or structure is regularly used as a Class 1 structure.
- (2) An outbuilding for a structure described in subdivision (1), such as a garage, barn, or family swimming pool, unless any part of the outbuilding is regularly used as a Class 1 structure.
 - (b) Subsection (a) does not include a vehicular bridge.
