The form must be attached to the Physical Environment Checklist and placed in the file if the resource home has a residential pool. All items must be marked "Yes" for the home to meet 675 IAC 20-1.1-1 requirements. If corrections are necessary, a new Residential Pool Requirements / Body of Water Safety Plan is required.

All areas over 3'6" have handholds around the perimeter, no further than 4' apart, and consist of one or a combination of the following: (a) Ledge or deck along the immediate top edge of the pool with slip-resisting surface of at least 4" minimum horizontal width, not more than 12" above the waterline. (b) Ladders, stairs, or seat ledges. (c) Secured rope or railing not more than 12" above the waterline.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Rope anchor device is installed between a minimum of 1' and maximum of 2' on the shallow end side of a change in floor slope. (a) If the change occurs in a depth less than 4'6", a transition rope supported by buoys is installed.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Access to pool is restricted by one of the following: (a) Wall or fence not less than 4' high and completely surrounding the pool & deck area with the exception of self-closing & latching gates & doors, both capable of being locked. (b) Other impenetrable means not less than 4' high completely surrounding the pool when not in use. (c) Combination of (a) and (b). (d) A power safety pool cover which: (1) Prohibits access to the pool when the cover is completely drawn over it. (2) Is mechanically operated by a key or key and switch & cannot be opened without a key or keypad. (3) Is installed with accessories to accomplish (1) or (2) in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
