



AFFIDAVIT OF CHALLENGED VOTER CONCERNING PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENT IN A SMALL TOWN ELECTION

INSTRUCTIONS: A "small town" is a town with a population of less than 3,500 which has established a town election board to conduct its election. This affidavit must be completed by a voter who: (1) was challenged because the voter was unable or declined to provide proof of identification and cast a provisional ballot; or (2) was challenged by a member of the precinct election board who determined that the proof of identification provided by the voter did not qualify under IC 3-5-2-40.5 and the voter cast a provisional ballot. This affidavit must be completed in person by the voter before the town election board or the town clerk-treasurer and filed not later than noon 10 days after election day.

Indiana Code 3-5-2-40.5: (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), "proof of identification" refers to a document that satisfies all the following: (1) The document shows the name of the individual to whom the document was issued, and the name conforms to the name in the individual's voter registration record. (2) The document shows a photograph of the individual to whom the document was issued. (3) The document includes an expiration date, and the document: (A) is not expired; or (B) expired after the date of the most recent general election. (4) The document was issued by the United States or the state of Indiana. (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(3), a document issued by the United States Department of Defense, the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (or its predecessor, the Veterans Administration), a branch of the uniformed services, the Merchant Marine, or the Indiana National Guard that: (1) otherwise complies with the requirements of subsection (a); and (2) has no expiration date or states that the document has an indefinite expiration date; is sufficient proof of identification for purposes of this title.
