The legal authority for this form is IC 9-18.5-2.

- INSTRUCTIONS:**
1. Complete in blue or black ink or print form.
 2. A Personalized License Plate (PLP) may be requested for registration on the following vehicles: passenger motor vehicle, truck with a declared gross vehicle weight of not more than 11,000 pounds, motorcycle, and recreational vehicle.
 3. A PLP message may be requested on any of the license plate types outlined in Indiana Code 9-18.5-2-1.
 4. A PLP may only be issued to a person who is the owner or lessee of the vehicle on which the license plate will be displayed.
 5. All requests for a PLP must be reviewed and approved by the BMV prior to issuance. Indiana Code 9-18.5-2-4 states that the BMV may refuse to issue a combination of letters or numerals, or both, that (1) carries a connotation offensive to good taste and decency; (2) would be misleading; or (3) otherwise considers improper for issuance.

SECTION 3 – PLP APPROVAL AND DENIAL INFORMATION

Approved PLP

If your PLP request is approved, your plate will be mailed to the mailing address printed on this form within thirty (30) days of your request.

You must continue to register the PLP each year. If the PLP is not registered and more than one (1) calendar year has passed since the last registration expiration date, the PLP becomes available to be requested by any other person on the following January 1. (For example: If your current registration expiration date is 7/28/2017, and you do not register your PLP through 7/28/2018, the PLP becomes available to be requested by any other person on 1/1/2019.)

Denied PLP

If your PLP request is denied, the BMV will mail a denial letter to the mailing address printed on this form. You may choose to select an alternate PLP message or to receive a standard license plate of the same plate type that you purchased with your initial PLP request.

Indiana Administrative Code 140 IAC 2-5-6 states that you may request an administrative review regarding the denial. The denial of the PLP will become final unless a written request for an administrative review is received by the BMV within eighteen (18) days after the date of the denial letter.

SECTION 4 – APPLICANT AFFIRMATION

I swear and affirm under the penalties for perjury that the information entered on this form is true and correct, that I am the owner or the lessee of the vehicle on which the PLP will be displayed, and that the BMV reserves the right to deny my personalized license plate request.
