



**AFFIDAVIT OF INSPECTOR AND JUDGES
CONCERNING CASTING OF VOTER'S BALLOT**

INSTRUCTIONS: If a voter leaves the polls without casting a ballot, an inspector, judge, clerk, or sheriff shall attempt to advise the voter not to leave the polls because the voter's ballot has not been cast, and permit the voter to return to the booth to complete the process of casting the ballot. If the voter has left the polls, or declines to return to the booth, the inspector shall direct both judges to enter the booth and, depending on the type of voting system used: (1) if a direct record electronic voting system is used, complete the process of casting the voter's ballot on the system; (2) if an optical scan ballot voting system is used, place the voter's ballot inside the envelope provided or fold the ballot and provide the envelope or ballot to the inspector to be deposited in the ballot box; or (3) if a traditional hand-counted paper ballot is used, provide the ballot to the inspector, to be deposited in the ballot box. The inspector and both judges shall then execute the following affidavit. The inspector may administer the oath to the judges, while one of the judges may administer the oath to the inspector.
